With Evin, Kodi, Amina, San, Usama, Anial, Iline, Ravi and Ruvini, Dinesh and Niranji. A series of intimate narratives is towered over by photos of silent commuters. Set apart is a disquieting installation combining the iconic Hill's Hoist with portraits printed onto delicate, swaying fabric; at first intriguing and familiar, it carries a bitter sting, offering a powerful statement about human rights in Australia over the last decade.
